- Abstract – max. 15 lines; Keywords – max. 7 words
- Article should be no longer than 60.000 characters, spaces included
- Authors are requested to include their full contact details and affiliation
- Bible quotations – New Revised Standard Version - NRSV (EN); Abkürzungen Theologie und Religionswissenschaften nach RGG⁴ (DE); Slovenský ekumenický preklad - EKV (SK, CZ)
- Short quotation – two lines remain in the main text
- Long quotation – three lines and longer are set off as *block quotes (italics)*
- Double quotation – “In the imagination of Western writers, she says, ‘Indian women lived out their days [...].’” (EN)
„Text1: ‘Text2’“ (DE, SK, CZ)
- use [...] instead [...], ... or ...
- use b. (born); d. (dead); c. (circa) (EN)
* (born); † (dead); um/ca. (circa) (DE, SK, CZ)
(*1928) or (†1928)
- use see instead cf. (EN)
vgl., por., srov. (DE, SK, CZ)
- - (hyphen/Bindestrich; Num-)
– (en dash/ Gedankenstrich; Ctrl+Num-)

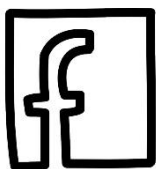
- use BCE/CE instead BC/AD (EN)

- napr., do not use napríklad (SK, CZ)
stor., do not use storočie
Jh. instead Jahrhundert (DE)

- δαιμόνια; do not use *δαιμόνια*, **δαιμόνια** or δαιμόνια

- [s.a.] – sine anno (unknown year of publication)
[s.n.] – sine nomine (publisher is unknown)
[s.l.] – sine loco (unknown place of publication)
[s.l. et a.]

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
